# IMPROVE PENCIL GRASP WITH HOUSEHOLD ITEMS:

1. PUSH TOOTHPICKS INTO A SPICE CONTAINER.
  2. THREAD BEADS ONTO DRY SPAGHETTI POKED INTO PLAY DOUGH. (WORK ON COLOR MATCHING WITH THIS ONE, TOO!)
  3. THREAD CEREAL ONTO STRING.
  5. DROP DRY BEANS INTO SMALL CONTAINERS.
  6. PRESS STICKS INTO PLAY DOUGH.
  7. POSITION WASHERS ONTO SCREWS.
  8. PAINT WITH SMALL SQUARES OF CUT UP KITCHEN SPONGES.
  9. PRESS PUSH PINS INTO A BULLETIN BOARD OR RECYCLED CONTAINERS.
  10. PUSH GOLF TEES INTO A SHOE BOX.
  11. PRESS GAME PIECES INTO PLAY DOUGH.
  12. USE TWEEZERS TO PLACE SMALL BALLS OF TISSUE PAPER INTO A CONTAINER.
